Ready to get started?

It is easy and free to set-up LibreView in three easy steps.



Step 1

Visit LibreView.com.au and click **Sign up**. If you have the FreeStyle Link App on your phone, you will have already created a LibreView account. Visit LibreView.com and login to your account.



Step 2

Download and follow the installation prompts. LibreView requires a one-time download of a device driver file to recognise compatible devices. Download and follow the prompts.



Step 3

Follow the on-screen instructions to upload your data.

Practice ID Code:

- 1 Ask your healthcare provider for their **Practice ID Code**. A practice ID is a code that is unique to each healthcare practice's LibreView account.
- 2 Go to your Settings section & select **Account Settings**.
- 3 Click on **My Practices**.
- 4 Enter in your healthcare provider's 'Practice ID Code' and click **Add**.
- 5 You should now see their name or their practice name appear under your practice list.

*To stop sharing data with a provider, click on **remove** next to the practice or provider's name under this list. Confirm that you want to remove them.*
